- To provide education support for 100 Children with Disabilities
- ➤ To create educational support system for Children with Disabilities (CwD's) through providing training for teachers and parents

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- **Introduction to the Uttar Pradesh/Solapur/Hyderabad Svastya programs.**
- Uttarpradesh we are serving 70 children with disabilities with human resource of 10 people in different professions
- Solapur we are serving presently 18 children with disabilities and we have 4 staff
- Hyderabad we are serving 25 children with disabilities and we have a team of 5 resources

Challenges Faced Last Year and Achievements

- **Limited Accessibility:** Accessibility barriers, including inadequate infrastructure and transportation options, hindered the participation of some children with disabilities.
- **Resource Constraints:** Limited availability of specialized educational materials and assistive technologies posed challenges in meeting the diverse needs of children with disabilities.
- **Stigma and Social Attitudes:** Deep-rooted societal stigmas and misconceptions surrounding disabilities presented obstacles in promoting inclusive practices and fostering acceptance within the community.



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Challenges Faced Last Year and Achievements

- Addressing Challenges:
- Collaborative Partnerships: Establishing partnerships with local authorities, community organizations, and disability advocacy groups helped address accessibility issues and expand resource networks.
- Innovative Solutions: Implementing creative solutions, such as mobile classrooms and community-based learning initiatives, helped overcome resource constraints and reach children in undeserved areas.
- Awareness Campaigns: Conducting awareness campaigns and sensitization sessions within the community helped challenge stereotypes and promote acceptance of children with disabilities, fostering a more inclusive environment.



Highlights of achievements, including milestones reached and successful activities.

- Distributing 44 assistive and adaptive devices to children with disabilities across all three locations! These devices are essential for improving the functional abilities of the children.
- According to the last Jan month ADL assessment total children improvement were 47.51 after 3 month children have been shown improvement 48.35. Toal

- 60 parents actively participated in the Parents Residential Training program, demonstrating a strong commitment to understanding and addressing the needs of their children with disabilities. Their involvement underscores the program's effectiveness in providing valuable support and guidance to families.
- The 2nd batch of teachers gathered at GiftAble Foundation on 8th December 2023, with 44 out of 50 teachers attending. Sessions addressed challenges in inclusive education, covering topics such as disabilities recognition, lesson adaptation, and effective classroom management

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Highlights of achievements, including milestones reached and successful activities.

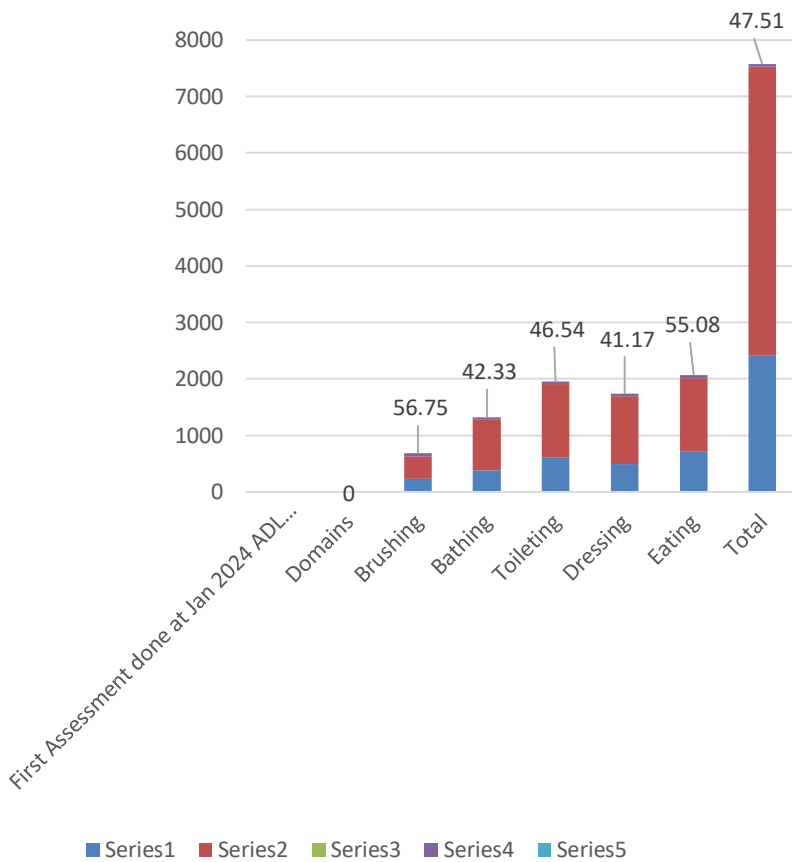
- A total of 157 children actively participated in the program, representing diverse backgrounds and abilities. Their engagement highlights the program's inclusive nature and broad reach within the community.



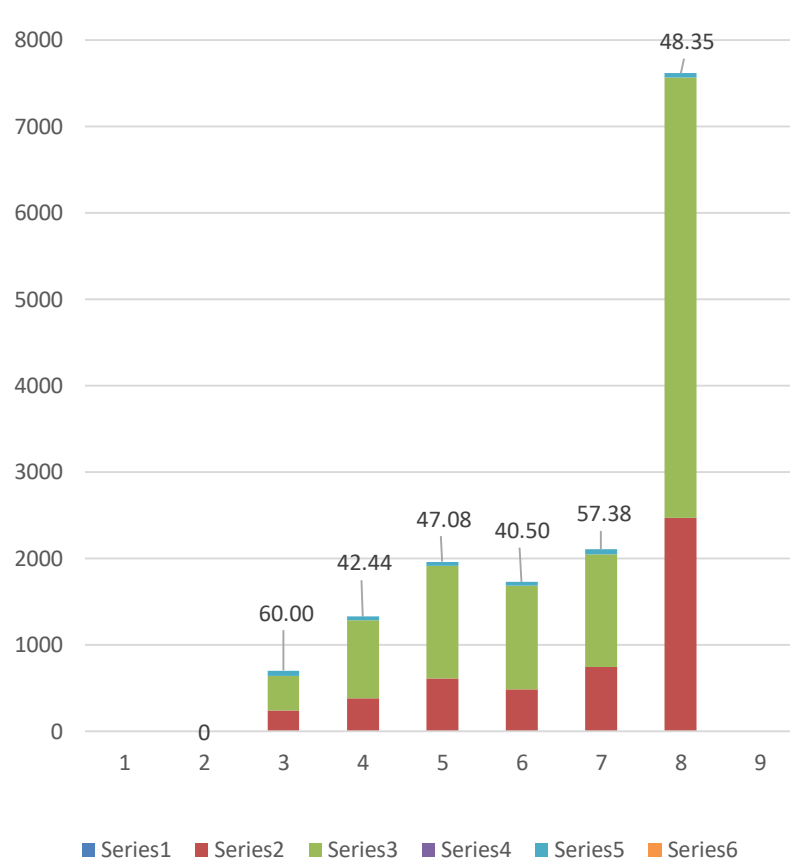
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Initial Assessment On Jan 2024
